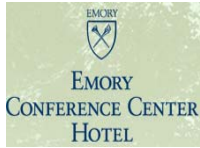

Methods for managing information databases and systems, as well as the evaluation of computer technology systems are included. The content provides an opportunity to prepare for the ANCC Nursing Informatics Certification Exam. The Conference is conducted by experts in Nursing Informatics.

- ◆ Assess readiness to complete the ANCC certification for nursing informatics, describe the initial application and follow-on recertification processes.
- ◆ Evaluate WINI and discuss content for future nursing informatics workshops.

Directions: 85 South: 85 South to North Druid Hills Road (Exit 89). At the end of the ramp, turn left onto North Druid Hills Road. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Briarcliff Road. At the 6th traffic light, turn left onto Clifton Road. The conference center is approximately (1) mile on the left at 1615 Clifton Road.

85 North (from airport): Take I-85 north to Exit 248C (Freedom Parkway). Follow the signs to the Carter Center and bear right on 42 east until it dead ends. Go left on Moreland Avenue; Moreland becomes Briarcliff. Stay on Briarcliff and go approximately three miles. Turn right on Clifton Road. At the 5th traffic light, make a left into the Emory Conference Center Hotel.

I-75: Follow signs to I-85 North (left exit). Follow I-85 North to Exit #89 North Druid Hills. At end of ramp turn right. At the second light, turn right on Briarcliff Road. At the sixth light, turn left on Clifton Road. The Emory Conference Center Hotel will be on the left approx 1 mile down Clifton.
